The Elizabethan House and Elizabethan Gardens are in New Street Nos 32 & 34. The Gin Distillery @ 60 Southside Street.</p> <p>Plymouth Hoe a wide open space with wonderful views across the sound. Smeaton's Lighthouse originally built on The Eddystone Reef in 1759 was relocated to The Hoe in the early 1880s.</p> |
